As a Coach in the Republic Parks and Recreation Department Program:

I pledge to consider the welfare of my players ahead of the personal desire to win.

I pledge to treat each child fairly remembering the large range of physical and emotional development for the same age groups.

I pledge to do my best to provide a safe playing environment for my players.

I pledge to lead by example, on and off the court or field, demonstrating fair play and sportsmanship to all my players.

I pledge to be knowledgeable in the rules of each sport that I coach and will teach and abide by the rules of the game.

I pledge to accept the role of official in providing judgement to ensure that competition is conducted fairly and according to the established rules.

I pledge to be courteous in my conduct with other coaches characterized by fair play and good faith.

I pledge to strive to provide each player with the opportunities for equal playing time.
