

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING AND AMENDING:

ORDINANCE NO. 05-10 AND IN LIEU THEREOF AMENDING AND ENACTING AS AMENDED CHAPTER 240, REPUBLIC CITY CODE, USER FEES FOR COMMUNITY SERVICES AND PARKS ACTIVITIES, SECTION 240.010, FEES, ESTABLISHING USER FEES FOR 2006

WHEREAS, the City of Republic, Missouri is a municipal corporation located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly created, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City, through its Parks & Recreation Department, has established and oversees a variety of recreational activities for the benefit of the citizens of Republic; and

WHEREAS, the City owns, operates and oversees the use of numerous buildings and facilities dedicated to providing leisure and recreational activities to its citizens; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust user fees for current programs, activities and facilities and establish user fees for new programs, activities and facilities to partially compensate the City for providing such services and activities and for permitting the use of such facilities;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 05-10 establishing certain user fees as codified in Section 240.010 of the Republic City Code is repealed and in lieu thereof Chapter 240, Republic City Code, User Fees For Community Services And Parks Activities is amended and enacted as amended as Section 240.010, Fees, establishing new user fees for parks & recreation programs, activities and facilities for the year 2006, such section to read as follows:

SECTION 240.010: FEES
