Issue Statement

To extend the current license agreement with SMOA to provide services at the Republic Senior Friendship Center.

Discussion and/or Analysis

The current license agreement with SMOA is about to expire. SMOA provides a large variety of services based out of the Republic Senior Friendship Center to senior citizens of our community. The extension to the agreement would call for the City of Republic's and SMOA's partnership to further extend to June 30, 2007.
