Project/Issue Name: Discussion and Possible Vote to Authorize Special Fireworks Display for Relay for Life.

Issue Statement

Vicky Hayward has contacted the Fire Department requesting a special fireworks aerial display permit for Relay for Life on June 23, 2006

Discussion and/or Analysis

Republic Municipal Code section 205.070 subsection B requires a civil and social organizations desiring to hold aerial fireworks displays on dates other than June thirtieth (30th) to July fourth (4th), inclusive, shall make application to the Board of Aldermen display special permit. Vicky Hayward has approached the Fire Department and requested such permit. The aerial display show will be shot from Garoutte Field by the staff of the Republic Fire Department. Display should occur at approximately 9:30 p.m. and last for five (5) minutes. The American Caner Society has the proper liability insurance in place for this event.

Recommended Action

Fire Chief recommends the Board of Aldermen authorize special display permit.

ARTICLE III. FIREWORKS

SECTION 205.070: FIREWORKS

B. Civic and social organizations desiring to hold aerial fireworks displays during the period of June thirtieth (30th) to July fourth (4th), inclusive, shall first contact the City Fire Department to request a permit. Upon approval, the City Fire Department shall issue the permit to said organization. In case of a rain out, said organization must inform the City Fire Department of the makeup date. Civil and social organizations desiring to hold aerial fireworks displays on dates other than June thirtieth (30th) to July fourth (4th), inclusive, shall make application to the Board of Aldermen at least fourteen (14) days prior to the date any such display is desired to be scheduled. Such application shall set forth the date and times during which such display is desired to be scheduled, the specific reasons as to why the display is to be held, and such other information as the Board may require, including the names and addresses of all persons responsible for conducting such display. If the Board of Alderman, in its discretion, is of the opinion such display would constitute a legitimate community event, it may issue a special permit authorizing the requested display. If any such display is authorized by special permit, nothing herein shall be construed as requiring the Board of Aldermen to authorize a special permit to the same organization for displays desired to be scheduled in successive years.
