Issue Statement

Ron Middleton is seeking approval of the Final Plat of Olde Town at the Kerr Place Subdivision. The plat proposes to subdivide 16 acres into 50 lots for the purpose of a single family residential development.

Discussion and/or Analysis

The Final Plat for Olde Town at the Kerr Place Subdivision will create 50 lots with a minimum lot size of 9,000 square feet. The Public Works Department Staff, Planning and Development Department Staff and Scott Consulting all reviewed the Final Plat for conformance with the City's Zoning and Subdivision Regulations. The Final Plat does meet all of the Zoning and Subdivision Regulations of the City of Republic. All required infrastructure has been installed by the Developer and approved by the City Subdivision Inspector.

Recommended Action

The Final Plat is in compliance with all regulations of the City's Zoning and Subdivision Regulations and the infrastructure has been constructed to the City's specifications for Subdivision Construction Design; therefore Staff recommends approval of the Final Plat of Olde Town at the Kerr Place Subdivision as submitted.
