

**AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE NAME
OF STATE HIGHWAY MM
TO BROOKLINE AVENUE.**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the Consolidation of the City of Republic and the Village of Brookline has caused a need to readdress City Streets and State Highways in the former Village of Brookline to ensure adequate emergency 911 services; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Staff, the City Addressing Committee, the Greene County Addressing Staff and the Postmasters did readdress certain areas of the former Village of Brookline; and

WHEREAS, the readdressing has caused some street names to change and has caused the name of State Highway MM to change; and

WHEREAS, the name of State Highway MM will change to Brookline Avenue from Highway 60 to James River Freeway; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Staff and the Greene County Addressing Staff will notify all homeowners of the address changes; and

WHEREAS, the Missouri Department of Transportation requires an Ordinance to be passed by the City Council in order for highway signs to be changed to reflect the new name of the State Highway; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC AS DESCRIBED, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the name "State Highway MM" is hereby changed to "Brookline Avenue" from Highway 60 north to James River Freeway.

SECTION 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its date of passage.
