

**RESOLUTION #07-R-05 OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, SUPPORTING THE ADOPTION OF BUILDING CODES IN THE  
UNINCORPORATED AREAS OF CHRISTIAN COUNTY, MISSOURI**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Republic has established building codes to promote the safety and welfare of its residents, and has long recognized the benefit of such building codes for the proper growth and development of its future residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the unincorporated areas outside the boundaries of the City of Republic do not have codes for minimum standards for construction in the unincorporated areas of Christian County; and

**WHEREAS**, the incorporated areas within Christian County are experiencing unprecedented growth and expansion by annexation into the unincorporated areas of the county resulting in the inheritance of potentially substandard structures that do not meet existing code standards of the City of Republic or any other City within the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Republic recognizes the need for a unified approach to future growth and development to avoid possible conflicts and problems that may require unnecessary expenditure of time, resources, and tax money to rectify these issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council of the City of Republic sees the obvious benefit of building codes to promote safety and welfare of future and existing citizens within its boundaries and the unincorporated areas of Christian County,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, the City Council of the City of Republic as follows:

1) The City Council requests that the Christian County Commission do everything within their power and their duties as elected officials to represent the best interest of all citizens within the County by adopting building codes in the unincorporated areas of Christian County.
