Issue Statement

Utilizing an Intergovernmental Agreement for bidding and purchasing asphalt construction work.

Discussion and/or Analysis

The 2008 budget for City Street Overlay includes the planned overlay of selected street segments. Working cooperatively with Greene County allows this work to be accomplished in the most effective and inexpensive manner. This arrangement has been utilized for the last four years and represents a substantial savings over unit prices that were submitted in the independent bids solicited by the City this year. The Intergovernmental Cooperative Agreement as submitted by Greene County establishes each party's responsibilities in this endeavor.

This item is tied to potential Council action on Agenda Item N, wherein the staff recommendation is to reject bids for asphalt work through a direct contract with the City. The overall concept is that this asphalt work will be performed through the terms of the IGA with Greene County.

Recommended Action

Public Works Director David Brock recommends passage and adoption of Ordinance #08-42 authorizing the execution of an Intergovernmental Agreement with Greene County for pavement overlay services.
