

CITYWIDE CLEAN-UP

EARTH DAY WEEKEND - April 21, 2018

Please read through this information carefully to ensure you meet the guidelines of this program!

The City has contracted with **Republic Services**, a private contractor, to conduct a street-by-street **curbside** clean-up of various household items (see the complete list of acceptable and non-acceptable items on the backside of this form). This is the second year for this great program and is being offered to provide Republic residents the opportunity to clean out their garage, basement or closets, and get rid of old worn out items and junk.

CURBSIDE PICK-UP

- * Citizens must have their acceptable items at the curb no later than 7:00 a.m. the morning of Saturday, April 21st, for pick-up and are encouraged to put items out the night before.
- * Any non-acceptable items that are included will be left at the curb for disposal by the resident.
- * Crews cannot access personal property to assist in moving items to the curb.
- * Clean-up will not take place at businesses, apartment buildings or at vacant homes.

DROP-OFF SERVICES

An area has been established at the Republic Aquatic Center, 711 E. Miller Road, to provide additional recycling opportunities for Republic residents. This location will be open to accept items from **9:00 a.m. until noon** on April 21st.

- * **Electronic Recycling** - Collection of old computers, routers, hubs, laptops, phones, printers, faxes, Christmas lights, exercise equipment, kitchen appliances, etc., for disposal. TVs and CRT Monitors will be accepted with a \$20 fee per item.
- * **Recycling Services** - Collection of recyclable plastic, paper, aluminum and glass will be available.

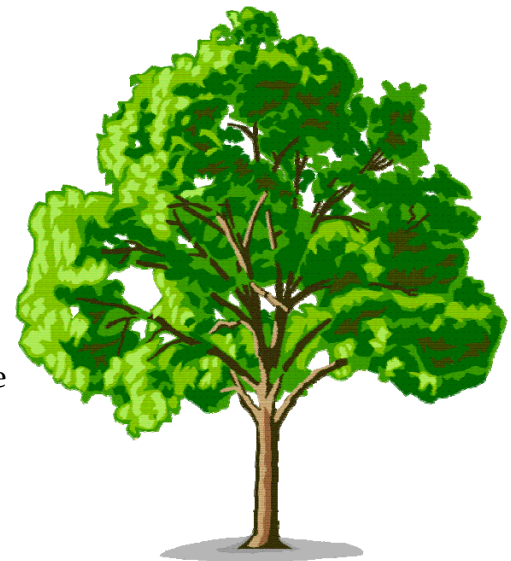
Yard Waste - The yard waste drop-off site, located at 915 North West Avenue, will be open to accept residential yard waste.

★ NEW in 2018 - Two sites will be available this year for the collection of tires. All tires must be separated from the wheel and brought to one of the two drop-off sites, located at the Republic Aquatic Center, 711 E. Miller Road, and at the yard waste drop-off site located at 915 North West Avenue.

HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL COLLECTION (HCC)

The Household Chemical Collection facility, located at 1226 W. Nichols in Springfield, is open weekly for the collection of your household chemicals. Contact their office for more information or to schedule an appointment.

CURBSIDE PICK-UP GUIDELINES

Acceptable items are to be bagged or bundled and placed at the curb for collection. **Items in a trash cart will not be accepted!** Normal day-to-day trash generated by a household is **not** included in this program.

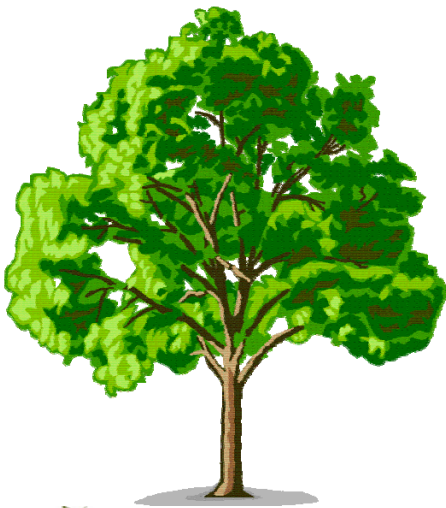
ACCEPTABLE ITEMS

- Furniture – Indoor/Outdoor
- Hand and Power Tools
- Beds/Mattresses
- Clothing
- Toys
- Grills - NO Propane Tanks
- Microwaves
- Washers/Dryers
- Carpeting/Padding (Must be cut in 4' or smaller sections)
- Wood (Must be cut in 4' or smaller sections and no bigger than 4" in diameter)
- Push Mowers/Weed Eaters (Must be drained of all fuel and oil)
- Basketball Goals (Must be in 4' or smaller sections to be collected)

Air Conditioners/Refrigerators/Freezers with Freon removed and properly tagged by a certified specialist will be accepted. If not properly tagged, the item will not be picked up. Doors must be removed from any appliance that presents a hazard to children.

ITEMS NOT ACCEPTED

- Tires (collected at drop-off sites)
- Home Remodeling Projects
- Brush/Limbs/Yard Waste (collected at drop-off site)
- Medical Items (Needles)
- Riding Lawn Mowers
- Bulk Liquids
- Propane Tanks
- Rocks, Bricks, Concrete
- Batteries
- Appliances with Freon that are not properly tagged.
- Fluorescent/CFL/HID Bulbs
- No Vehicle Parts (Motors, Doors, Hoods, etc.)
- Hazardous Waste (including paint, oil, aerosol cans, fertilizers, etc.)



Citizens must have their items at the curb no later than 7:00 a.m. the morning of Saturday, April 21st, for pick-up and are encouraged to put the items out the evening of April 20th.

This is a free service provided by the City of Republic and the City reserves the right to refuse any items for clean-up that do not meet the criteria of the program or that pose a threat to the health or safety of an employee or individual participating in the collection process.
