Issue Statement

To approve the purchase of one (1) new Police vehicle and outfitting of said vehicle with the appropriate safety equipment.

Discussion and/or Analysis

The Republic Police Department would like to purchase one (1) 2017 Ford Utility Police Interceptor for the Admin/Investigation Division. This vehicle will be purchased from Republic Ford for \$373.00 less than the State Bid amount on the vehicle. The vehicle will be outfitted with the appropriate safety equipment to make it functional.

This purchase was approved by Council in the 2017 Budget. The purchase of this vehicle will be accomplished through a reserve cash account identified by the Finance Director and Police Chief for purchases of equipment and vehicles. This account was set up many years ago to make smaller capital improvement purchases without impacting the General Fund budgeting for the Police Department.

Recommended Action

Police Chief Lawton recommends approving the purchase and outfitting of one (1) new Police vehicle for the department fleet, not to exceed \$28,018.00 for the purchase of the vehicle and \$5,000.00 for the necessary safety equipment package, totaling \$33,018.00.

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI,
AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) POLICE VEHICLE**

WHEREAS, the City of Republic, Missouri, (herein called the "City") is a municipal corporation and Charter City located in Greene County, Missouri, being duly created, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Missouri; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase one (1) new Ford Utility Police Interceptor for the Admin/Investigation Division from Republic Ford to fill the needs of the Police Department fleet and outfit it with the appropriate safety equipment; and

WHEREAS, this vehicle will improve the safety of our officers and the public in the delivery of service.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REPUBLIC, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. To approve the purchase of one (1) new police vehicle under the Missouri State Bid purchase agreement, not to exceed a total cost of \$28,018.00 for the vehicle and \$5,000.00 for the safety equipment package, totaling \$33,018.00.




